Backgrounder

ISN 10019 Encep Nurjaman Hambali (kunyaas “Riduan bin Isomuddin,” “Riduan Isomuddin,” “Azman,” “Alejandro Davidson Gonzalez,” “Kahar,” “Mizi,” “Muzabar,” “Samsuri,” and “Daniel Suarez Naviera”), born April 4, 1964, is a citizen of Indonesia. He was transferred to GTMO custody in September 2006.

The detainee’s initial periodic review hearing occurred on 18AUG2016. The government reported that he has been a compliant detainee, though he has used his position of leadership to promote violent jihad in prayers. The government asserts that ISN 10019 partially led the Jemaah Islamiyah, facilitated and arranged financing for several bombings in Indonesia, and recruited Yazid Sufaat for the development of weaponized anthrax for Al Qa’eda. The detainee’s personal representatives lauded him for using his time at GTMO to educate himself in languages, watch documentaries, and pursue other forms of self-improvement.

ISN 10019 has undergone four file reviews on 15MAR2017, 25OCT2017, 17OCT2018, and 10APR2019, which all concluded that no question was raised as to if his continued detention was warranted. His Periodic Review Board (PRB) subsequent full review hearing has been triggered by process requirements.
