Also, there are now 63 delegations (!) coming to a meeting that is scheduled, with dinner, to last two hours. If each delegation speaks for only three minutes, that is already 189 minutes, not including the introductory remarks by [redacted] (who will both open the meeting and, later, give national remarks). [redacted] said that only those delegations really needing to speak would do so; I wondered whether, if people came all the way here, they would really be willing to sit silently. [redacted] said that he expected [redacted] would exercise the right type of discipline to keep things moving at the right pace. But we may want to keep our intervention as brief as possible.
