We are making use of multiple sources of modeling including work from <u>University of Michigan</u>, IHME's <a href="https://covid19.healthdata.org/projections">https://covid19.healthdata.org/projections</a>,

the <u>COVIDACTNOW.ORG</u> site, running rough projections using assumptions in a paper from <u>Imperial College</u>, and working with McKinsey Group.

Each model is dependent on the data used to develop it including how timely and specific the data are to geography, onset date of illness, case count, community spread data, observance of shelter in place orders/social distancing, death data, etc.

We continue to urge Michiganders to follow Governor Whitmer's Stay Home, Stay Safe Order and to practice social distancing to help slow the spread of COVID-19 in our state.
