#### 1. Statement of Need

The Division of Drug Safety Research (DDSR) OTR/OPS/CDER is developing a research program to evaluate the usefulness of humanized mice (HM) for regulatory purposes. The HM are created by surgical implantation of human tissue into mice that have multiple genetic mutations that block the development of the mouse immune system at a very early stage. The absence of the mouse immune system allows the human tissues to grow and develop into functional human tissues. As part of this process DDSR needs to repeatedly acquire the proper type of tissues. In order for the humanization to proceed correctly we need to obtain fetal tissue with a specific set of specialized characteristics.

### 2. Statement of Work (SOW)/Performance Work Statement (PWS)

The supplier will provide human fetal tissue with the following characteristics:

- Age range 16-24 weeks
- Liver and thymus tissue from the same donor unless liver only is requested.
