evacuate the chamber.

Officer explained that the radio was very busy, with multiple priorities. He explained that normally, voting is a routine process, and this was far from routine with the demonstrators breaching the Capitol. He is not able to estimate the number of demonstrators, as he was in the Chamber, and could not see what was going on the west side of the building. The demonstrators were trying to breach the main door to the House. So, they evacuated the Members of Congress. There were also demonstrators at the east door to the House.

He explained that the demonstrators were yelling, cursing at the officers, making obscene gestures. He did not actually hear shots fired, he thought it was the windows being broken out, but the radio announced, "Shots fired."

While he noted that Lieutenant Byrd was shaken, he did not say anything. He has worked with him for about a year. He observed that Lieutenant Byrd was nervous, teary-eyed, and appeared very upset. His voice also shaky when he called for medical assistance over the radio.

Lieutenant Byrd was still very upset. Another Sergeant took charge of the group of officers, and had them all walk to the Rayburn subway.
