**INTERNAL BACKGROUND:**

This story was initially reported by The Blaze in October 2020. A FOIA request was completed at the time, that resulted in no USSS records being found. The Politico reporter refused to provide any details on the source of the information or that he was in possession of any official document identifying the USSS.
