MINUTE ORDER. For the reasons stated on the record, it is ORDERED that the parties' pending [12] [23] cross-motions for summary judgment are DENIED *WITHOUT PREJUDICE*. It is further ORDERED that the parties shall meet and confer and file updated briefs in accordance with the following schedule. On or before September 14, 2023, the parties shall meet and confer and Defendants shall submit additional information regarding the set of 271 emails described in paragraph 7 of the declaration at Dkt. 12-3. Such additional information may be in the form of a *Vaughn* index, its functional equivalent, or an updated declaration with further detail. Defendants need not provide additional information on those categories of emails that Plaintiff conceded at oral argument were likely not public records. Defendants' motion to dismiss under Rule 12(b)(1) or in the alternative for summary judgment is due on or before September 29, 2023. Plaintiff's response is due on or before October 30, 2023. Defendants' reply is due on or before November 14, 2023. If the Court denies Defendants' motion, it will issue a further order with respect to the production of documents and/or video footage.
