Hundreds of "rioters" as well as congressional staffers and press were encountered inside the US Capitol Building. SRT did not detain/arrest any individuals. ***SEQUENCE OF EVENTS - continued from next page*** Once all known protesters had been removed from the building and the exterior doors were secured, SRT began to coordinate with the CERT Commander on searching and clearing the U.S Capitol Building prior to Congress going back into session (we were advised this would happen at 2000 hours). Over the next several hours, combined teams of CERT personnel, Uniformed Park Police, SRT operators, ATF Field Agents and FBI Bomb Technicians searched and cleared the majority of the U.S Capitol Building (note-some areas were not cleared due to the sensitivity of the area or the inability to access a locked door). No breaching was authorized except for doors that could be opened with a master key (Park Police). The building was considered "clear" at approximately 2000 hours. Due to the breach of Capitol and Congress returning to session, the CERT commander asked SRT to maintain two elements (of at least 4 operators each) stationed with CERT personnel outside of the chambers until Congress adjourned their session. It was estimated that the maximum amount of time for this would be 23 more hours. SRT began a rotation and SOD scheduled to have SRT 5 replace SRT 2 personnel at approximately 0900 on 1/7/21. At approximately 2300 hours, SRT 2 reduced the total number of personnel on scene (no longer required based on the threat). Eleven operators and one medic remained at the US Capitol to help CERT secure the senate chambers. The remaining SRT personnel were released. On 1/7/21, at approximately 0345, CERT personnel advised that Congress had adjourned and

Sequence of Events:

At approximately 1345 hours on 1/7/21, SAC WFD contacted [IDIGIDITION] and asked for the SRT to immediately deploy to a staging location close to the U.S Capitol Building to support the Capitol Police with a growing and potentially violent crowd. [IDIGIDITION] passed this request to all deploying team members and to DC-SOD. While the team was en-route to the operation, [IDIGIDITION] continued to receive and relay updated intelligence to all responding personnel.

The following intelligence was received and relayed from approximately 1350 hours until the first SRT elements arrived on scene (in the order it was received):

- -US Capitol Police made a request for mutual aid
- -Chemical Agents have been deployed at the US Capitol
- -Breach of the Capitol is imminent (windows and doors broken by large crowd)
- -A live explosive device had been recovered near the US Capitol
- -The Capitol building had been breached and a large crowd was now inside
- -Shots had been fired inside the US Capitol

At 1445 hours, the initial SRT elements arrived on scene and quickly coordinated with ASAC and SAC WFD (both on scene) and a SGT from US Capitol Police CERT (Containment and Emergency Response Team). Arriving elements were immediately tasked with assisting CERT in responding to the numerous calls for assistance from officers/staffers inside of the U.S. Capitol Building. At approximately 1455 hours, SRT elements (paired with CERT operators) made entry into the U.S. Capitol Building and began assisting CERT personnel respond to the numerous calls for assistance throughout the building.

As additional operators arrived at the staging location, they were directed into the building by ASAC WFD and then linked up with SRT elements.

SRT initially deployed as a single element, but as additional operators/medics arrived/linked up with the team, the SRT was split into 2 elements and eventually into 3 elements (for easier command and control and mission flexibility). The elements worked both separately and together depending on the tasking by CERT operators. At all times, CERT operators accompanied the SRT elements to ensure command and control with the Capitol Police (SRT had no direct radio communications with the Capitol Police).

For the first couple of hours, SRT assisted in removing the protesters from the building and provided additional security to U.S. Capitol Police officers manning entry points into the building. At one point during this time, SRT/CERT responded to office H-329 (Rep. Clyburn's office), believed by U.S. Capitol Police to be occupied by protesters. All doors to the office were locked and appeared to be barricaded. At the direction/request of CERT personnel, SRT assisted with breaching and clearing the office. It was occupied by numerous congressional staff members, guests and press. All were identified and escorted from the office by U.S. Capitol Police.

I am a retired Veteran who is grieved by Ashli Babbitt's untimely death on 01/06/21.

I have watched video footage and read articles and have not seen the two men referenced in this interview: https://youtu.be/5nvqvvsqJ_s

having had charges nor arrests made of them in the news.

One perp who attacked the doors--hammering them with a helmet handed to him by his accomplice-and had verbally accosted the officers stationed in front of the doors was wearing a \$350.00 Canada Goose hat: https://www.canadagoose.com/ca/en/aviator-hat-5187M.html?cgid=shop-mens-hats Such a hat was not likely to be worn by a Trump supporter. Also, immediately after the shooting, this same man is seen changing his clothes behind the officers in the adjacent staircase.

The behavior of these two men, along with that of (b)(6)/(b)(7)(C) fits the profile of provocateurs assisting with creating a scene of violence.

Sadly, Ashli Babbit was drawn into the chaos created by these actors and paid the ultimate price for their coordinated disturbance.

Please investigate these two men and file charges against them for their actions. While not directly assisting in Ashli's death, they provided the means for her unbridled zeal to be expressed in her moment of poor judgement.
