



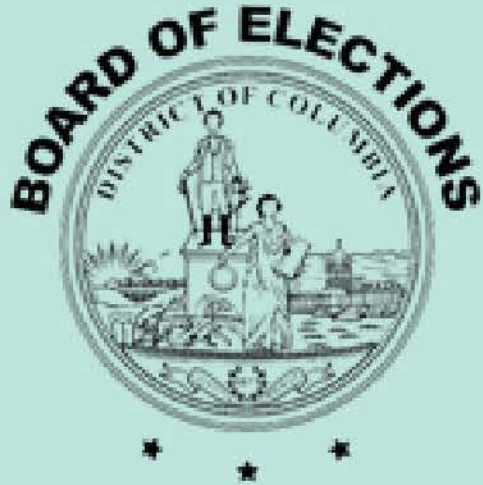

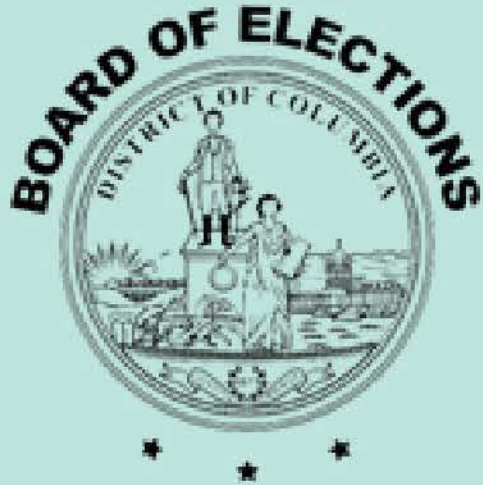

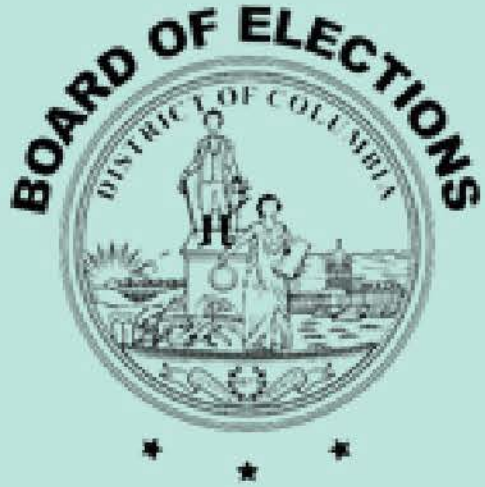


- Independent agency of the District of Columbia government
Non-partisan (No political affiliations)
Responsibilities include: elections, ballot access, and voter registration
Small agency (less than 100 employees)
Located near the Washington Nationals baseball stadium

NON-CITIZEN VOTING IN DC



- Non-US citizen residents of the District of Columbia can vote in local elections under the Local Resident Voting Rights Amendment Act of 2022. Non-US citizen residents can vote in District elections for the offices of Mayor, Attorney General, Chairman or member(s) of the DC Council, member(s) of the State Board of Education, or Advisory Neighborhood Commissioner(s). Non-US citizen residents cannot vote for Federal Offices.



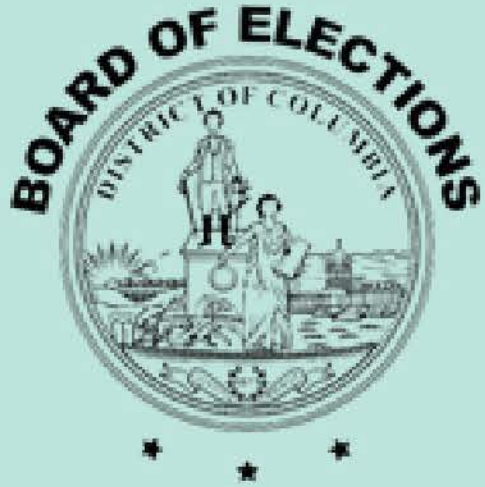
VOTER ELIGIBILITY

To register to vote in the District of Columbia as a non-citizen, you must:

- Be at least 17 years old and 18 years old by the next General Election;
- Maintain residency in the District of Columbia for at least 30 days prior to the election in which you intend to vote;
- Not claim voting residence or the right to vote in any state, territory, or country;
- Not been found by a court to be legally incompetent to vote.

WHAT DO I NEED TO REGISTER TO VOTE IN DC?

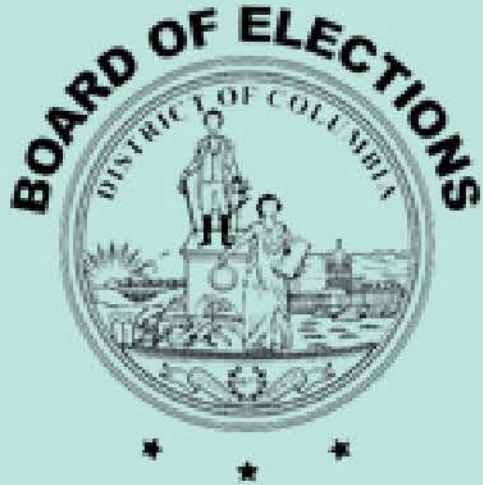
- ✓ Full name
District address
Date of birth
Must be registered to vote with one of the parties that is eligible to conduct a primary election (Democratic, Republican, or D.C. Statehood Green) otherwise can select Independent (can only vote in General elections)

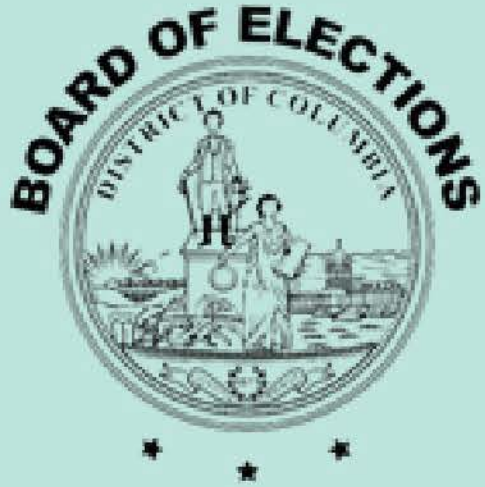


PROOF OF RESIDENCE



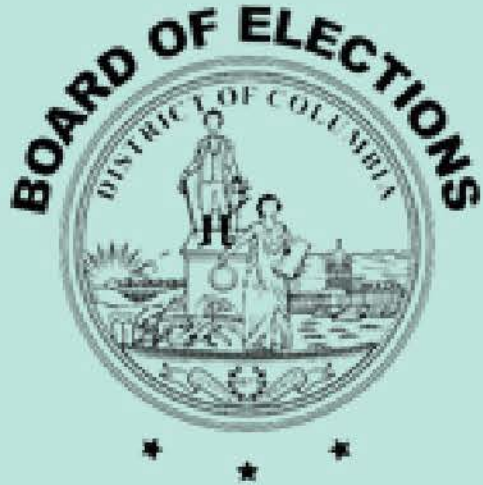
- A copy of a current and valid government-issued photo identification
A copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, or paycheck (dated no earlier than 90 days before the date upon which you mail your application or, if you do not submit proof by mail or online, 90 days before the date you vote)
Any other government-issued document

- Online → <https://www.dcboe.org/noncitizenvoter> PDF voter registration forms available in multiple languages By mail (postage prepaid) By email (scanned as an attachment or just take a picture with cell phone and send via email) → DCRegistration@dcboe.org In-person (visiting our office or any voter registration agency, or you may register and vote at the same time during Early Voting and Election Day (Same Day Registration))

In-person voting Early voting date: Sunday, May 26, 2024 - Sunday, June 2, 2024 *** Closed Monday, May 27, 2024 for Memorial Day *** Primary Election Date: Tuesday, June 4, 2024

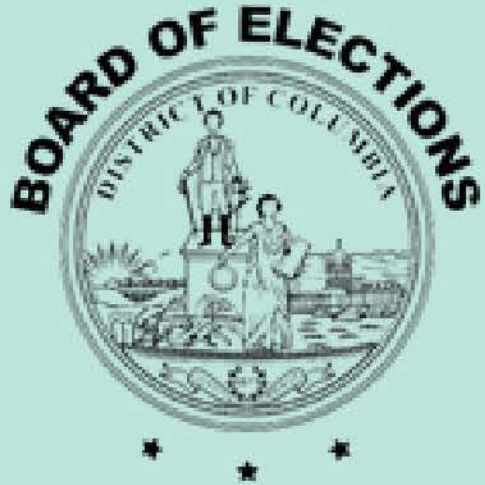

CAN I REGISTER TO VOTE SAME DAY FOR EARLY VOTING OR PRIMARY ELECTION?

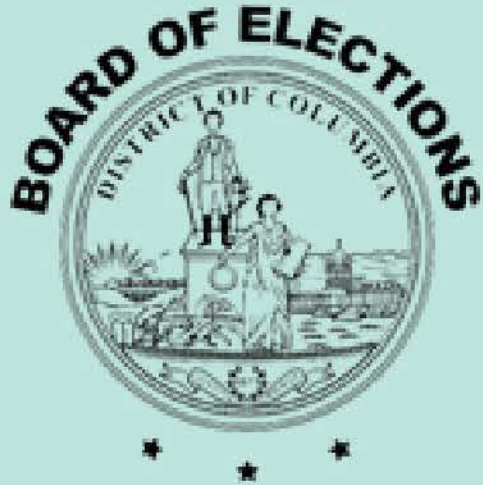


Yes!

You must provide proof of your address in the District of Columbia at an Early Vote Center prior to Election Day or at the polling place assigned to your address on Election Day.

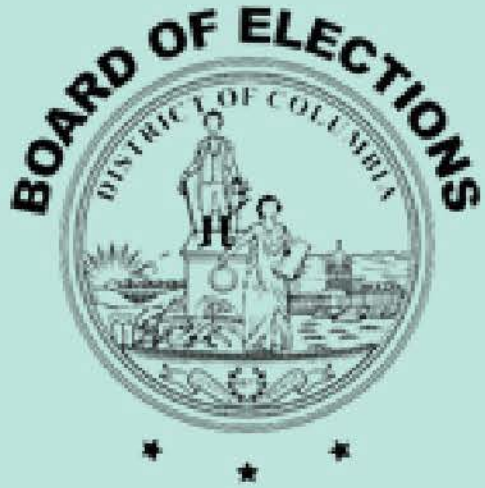
