UPDATES IN RED

SITUATION:
On April 29, 2020, at approximately 1705 hours, (b)(7)(E) Border Patrol Agents (BPAs) in the field notified the (b)(7)(E) Border Patrol Station Duty Des (b)(7)(E) regarding a downed drone containing possible narcotics. Supervisory Border Patrol Agents (SBPAs) arrived on scene and photographed the evidence. BPAs seized and transported the drone and possible narcotics to (b)(7)(E) Station. The Yuma Sector Evidence Team (SET) was notified and responded to the (b)(7)(E) Station for testing and fingerprinting.

TIMELINE:
1705 hours: While (b)(7)(E) in (b)(7)(E) BPAs noticed a drone and another object laying on the north side of (b)(7)(E) BPAs notified (b)(7)(E) of the discovery of a downed drone containing possible narcotics at (b)(7)(E) AZ.
1710 hours: Yuma SET Operations Officer was notified and responded.
1724 hours: The Air and Marine Operations Center (AMOC) DEO was notified. AMOC will (b)(7)(E) to identify a possible timeframe.
1755 hours: BPAs arrived at (b)(7)(E) Station with the drone and possible narcotics.
1854 hours: Narcotics tested positive for methamphetamine (462.82g).
