Narrative (Indicate Block No. in left margin) <p>Monday October 21, 2024, at approximately 1100 hrs, I, [REDACTED], received a call from [REDACTED] on my state issued cell phone [REDACTED] advised that there was another email complaint regarding allegations of unlawful possession of a squirrel and raccoon, similar to the previous emailed complaints. [REDACTED] forwarded the email to my state email and advised to investigate and discuss with [REDACTED].</p> <p>Monday October 21, 2024, at approximately 1400 hrs, I received an email from the R8 Wildlife mailbox on my state email inbox. This email included a forwarded email from the complainant alleging the same as mentioned above.</p> <p>During the week of October 22, 2024, I held multiple conversations, via state cell phone, state email, and in person, between DLE, BECI and Wildlife staff, regarding the complaints. Lists of licensed wildlife rehabilitators for regions 7-9, as well as rabies vector species rehabbers, was received from wildlife staff. It was confirmed that Longo did not possess a wildlife rehabilitators license. A discussion was had via state email to determine a location for the wildlife to go in case they needed to be held. [REDACTED] and I decided it would be best if he contacted Chemung County Department of Health as [REDACTED] had specific questions he wanted to ask regarding the raccoon since it is a rabies vector species.</p> <p>On Wednesday October 23, 2024, I met with [REDACTED], to discuss the basics of this case. It was decided that [REDACTED] and I would meet on 10/24/24 at the R8 office to begin working on the case file. At approximately 1400 hrs, I received an email from [REDACTED] with information from the Chemung County Department of Health, regarding guidance on how to proceed with testing wildlife found during the investigation.</p> <p>Thursday October 24, 2024, I met with [REDACTED] at the R8 Office to discuss the case and began researching social media accounts of suspect Mark Longo. I observed several videos on TicToc, Facebook, and Instagram relating to the suspected unlawful possession of squirrels and raccoons on accounts held by Mark Longo. I explained to BECI Members that I had a previous complaint on this case, Event 24-015856, but it was determined to generate a new event with the recent complaints. I also met with R8 Wildlife Biologist, [REDACTED] to discuss the investigation that DLE was conducting on the complaint.</p> <p>While meeting with [REDACTED], we had a phone conference call, on his state cell phone, with [REDACTED]. It was determined that BECI would be the lead on this case as it was determined a search warrant was going to be the route to take. [REDACTED] stated that he would begin working on the search warrant and researching the social media accounts associated with Longo.</p> <p>Monday October 28, 2024, at approximately 1200 hrs, I met [REDACTED] at the Bath Sub-office to discuss the search warrant and other pertinent information regarding the case. At approximately 1500 hrs, I drove by 37 Beckwith Rd, Pine City, in my assigned patrol vehicle and photographed the driveway entrance utilizing my state issued cell phone. I then sent those photographs to [REDACTED] for the case file.</p> <p>Tuesday October 29, 2024, I discussed the case with [REDACTED] via state cell phone to see what needed to be done for the case. I also spoke with [REDACTED] via state cell phone, to advise that I would obtain contact information for potential resources if we located unlawfully possessed wildlife. Afterward, utilizing my state issued cell phone, I called the Chemung County Department of Health and spoke with [REDACTED]. I provided [REDACTED] with a summary of the case and then requested their suggestion on what they would like done with any wildlife located during the investigation. [REDACTED] advised that if any of the wild animals had contact with humans, they would most likely need to be submitted for rabies testing. [REDACTED] advised that they utilize the Elmira Animal Control for euthanasia and submission of rabies testing and suggested I contact them.</p> <p>After speaking with [REDACTED], I contacted Elmira Animal Control and spoke with the [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that only one of the technicians performed euthanasia, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] advised to call the Elmira Animal Shelter to speak with [REDACTED] to see if she was available for the request. [REDACTED] stated that she would be available to assist on Wednesday if we needed her assistance.</p> <p>After coordinating with the Chemung County Department of Health and Elmira Animal Control, I called approximately 12 licensed wildlife rehabilitators in R8. If the rehabber didn't answer, I tried to leave a voicemail. If the rehabber answered, or called back, I inquired if they would be able to accept a squirrel for temporary holding/rehabbing. At approximately 1206 hrs, I received a return call from one of the licensed wildlife rehabilitators, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] advised that she was willing to take the squirrel if needed. I advised that I would call if we needed to bring the squirrel to them. At approximate 1208 hrs, I received another return call from a different rehabber, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] advised that she was willing to take the squirrel if needed. I advised that another licensed rehabilitator had already stated they would be willing to take in a squirrel.</p> <p>Wednesday October 30, 2024, at approximately 0930, I, met with all DEC members involved in the search warrant, for a briefing. From approximately 1035 hours to approximately 1400 hours, I assisted with the execution of a search warrant at 37 Beckwith Road, T/Southport, Chemung County. Upon arrival to the location and after primary contact with Longo by BECI, I stayed with Longo for the duration of the search. Initially Longo denied possessing any wildlife. After the safety sweep, Longo escorted me to the balcony off an upstairs bedroom and showed me an enclosure that he stated he kept four (4) raccoons in for a short time until they "broke out" of the enclosure and left. I did not observe any raccoons at that time.</p> <p>Upon returning downstairs, it was discovered that, Longo's wife admitted to another DLE member that the raccoon was upstairs in a bedroom closet. Longo stated that was the only wild animal in the residence, saying that the squirrel was taken to Connecticut.</p>

At approximately 1400 hrs, I called Chemung County Department of Health via state cell phone and spoke with [REDACTED]. Once I reached [REDACTED], and after introducing myself, I put the phone on speaker so that [REDACTED] was present during the conversation. [REDACTED] introduced himself and then we advised [REDACTED] that a squirrel and raccoon that cohabitated a common living area, were confiscated during the investigation. [REDACTED] was advised that the squirrel had bitten a DEC employee, that the incident and investigation is high profile and then was asked if the animals should be tested for rabies since the raccoon is a rabies vector species. [REDACTED] stated that both animals should be tested as a precaution as she didn't want to chance it.

At approximately 1404 hrs, I spoke to [REDACTED] via state cell to advised that I would be bringing a squirrel and raccoon to the Elmira Animal Control that needed to be euthanized and tested for rabies as per the direction of County Health Department. [REDACTED] agreed to meet at the Animal Shelter.

The raccoon and the squirrel, each in their own crate, were transported by [REDACTED] in the back of a DEC wildlife vehicle to the Elmira Animal Control while I followed in my assigned state vehicle.

Upon arrival to the Animal Control Office, [REDACTED] advised that he had called [REDACTED] again to reiterate the specifics of the case and to emphasis that the case is high profile. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] said that it didn't change anything and that the animals would need to be tested.

[REDACTED] and I met with [REDACTED] and brought the raccoon and squirrel into the facility. I assisted [REDACTED] and another Animal Control Officer in transferring the raccoon and squirrel into different enclosures so that Detota would be able to euthanize them utilizing drugs that she is certified to use.

Once both the raccoon and squirrel were euthanized, [REDACTED] stated that it would probably be too late to submit the samples to Chemung County Department of Health so she would take the samples the following day.

I departed Elmira Animal Control at approximately 1520 hrs.

11-6-24	reporting – On July 11th 2024, DEC Wildlife division made me aware of potential illegally possessed racoon at 37 Beckwith Road, Pine City, NY 14871. Suspects names are Mark & Daniela Longo (reference event # 24-5856). I assigned the investigation to [redacted] with direction to coordinate with [redacted] as he had been assigned investigations regarding multiple allegations of a captive squirrel at the same location during January and May 2024 (reference Event's 24-000509, and 24-010081, 24-010224). When I asked about the status of the case during the zone meeting on September 18th, [redacted] and [redacted] indicated that they had been in coordination but that the investigation was still ongoing. DEC Wildlife staff continued to receive several new citizen complaints regarding captive raccoons during October 2024, which led to the decision for the case to be handled via application of a search warrant to obtain the alleged captive raccoons. On October 22nd I requested that [redacted] assist [redacted] with drafting a search warrant application. On October 23rd [redacted], and I met with [redacted] to discuss the case and the search warrant application. At that time we were directed to proceed with the search warrant application. On October 24th [redacted] notified me that he was given direction by [redacted] that BECI Investigators would be taking over as the primary investigators on this case with support from Uniform ECO's as needed. A search warrant was obtained and the decision was made to execute said warrant on Wednesday October 30th in conjunction with BECI/Uniform ECO's/Wildlife staff. Uniform ECO's each were assigned various peripheral roles related to execution of the search warrant. [redacted] and I were assigned to site security. [redacted] secured firearms located on site while I was tasked with controlling access by uninvolved bystanders for officer safety purposes. End of Supplement MTL #486.

Later in the morning of 11/5, I met with ██████ (evidence custodian) in the NYSDEC Avon Office evidence prep area. There, I witnessed ██████ place items #3 4 into a cardboard long gun box for safe transport. The items can be described as a Delta Level Defense rifle and a separate rifle upper component. ██████ tied the items to the bottom of the box, sealed the box with evidence tape, and labeled the box accordingly. I observed ██████ re-secure the box containing the rifle back in the evidence room.

On 11/6/24, I patrolled to the NYSDEC Avon Region 8 Office where I met with ██████ (evidence custodian). I received from ██████ a box containing items #3 4 related to this investigation, namely those items that had been boxed up previously on 11/5. ██████ relinquished the box to me with a chain of custody record. I then patrolled to the NYSP Forensics Lab in Albany where I met with NYSP personnel at the evidence intake counter. There, I observed the personnel open the box to verify its contents. I relinquished the box, rifle, and separate upper rifle component to their custody and departed the lab. (See DEC evidence chain of custody record and NYSP Crime Lab Evidence Submission form).

10/22/24 I received an email from [REDACTED] on my day off requesting assistance with a possible search warrant regarding a case of illegal possession of wildlife in Chemung County. The case is currently being handled by [REDACTED]. I contacted [REDACTED] via phone, and we determined we would discuss the matter with [REDACTED] further at the R8 Bloc meeting the next day. Based upon the email chain sent from [REDACTED] to [REDACTED], [REDACTED], BOW staff and the Chemung County Dept of Health had been in discussions regarding this matter for several days.

10/23/23 [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] discussed the possible need to draft a search warrant regarding the recent complaints of Mark Longo in possession of a squirrel and a raccoon, as well as DLE's history with the subject. I advised [REDACTED] of my likely BECI assist to R8 uniform regarding the case.

10/24/24 AM Working with [REDACTED] I began investigating the allegation that Mark Longo of 37 Beckwith Rd Pine City, NY is in possession of a squirrel and at least one raccoon at his residence in violation of NYS ECL. I was forwarded several email complaints that were received to the R8dispatch and R8wildlife email in the past week or so. The email complaints were referring to Mark Longo of 37 Beckwith Rd Pine City, NY making social media posts that he is in possession of a squirrel and at least one raccoon. I was forwarded emails from BOW staff that show Mark Longo does not have any license or permit from DEC to possess the animals.

10/24/24 1114 I was contacted by [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and they stated that this case was going to be handled by BECI and I was assigned to it. At 1142 I opened event 24-025504. [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and I discussed a possible timeline to execute a search warrant pending my investigation. Most of my investigation was done by viewing emails, videos, photographs, and social media posts made by Mr. Longo that show him in possession of a squirrel and at least one raccoon. I spoke to ECO Dalecki regarding his past complaint at the residence.

10/25/24 I continued my investigation through searches on the internet, social media pages and posts, emails, videos, and photographs. I sent an email to each of the four complainants advising them that we are working on the case and how they could reach me if they had further information to provide. Based upon the complaints, and my firsthand investigation I was able to determine that there was reasonable cause to believe that Mark Longo of 37 Beckwith Rd Pine City, NY was in possession of a raccoon, and a grey squirrel (black in color) at his residence recently in violation of NYS ECL. I documented the evidence that I gathered in my electronic case file.

10/27/24 I drafted a search warrant application, and a search warrant based upon my investigation. I advised [REDACTED] that we can move forward with the execution of the warrant either Tuesday or Wednesday pending his review and a Justice's signature.

10/27/24 1248 I was contacted by a person known to me as [REDACTED] via phone, on a number with No Caller ID. The person claimed to be one of the complainants and was able to corroborate certain information from the complaint, and social media posts made by Mark Longo online. The caller did not wish to give a written statement and wished to remain anonymous for fear of retaliation.

10/28/24 I patrolled to the Bath Sub office and continued preparing the search warrant application, search warrant, and operational plan. [REDACTED] reviewed my warrant and application. After his review he recommended that I change format of the warrant. I changed the warrant format and worked on my case file.

10/28/24 I contacted [REDACTED] of DEC special licenses via phone and was advised that Mr. Longo did take the wildlife rehabilitator exam and that we have an application of his on file. [REDACTED] stated Longo has not completed the process to become a rehabilitator and no licenses or permits to possess wildlife have been granted to Mark Longo at this time. I spoke to [REDACTED] of BOW via phone, and he also confirmed that Mark Longo has no licenses or permits to possess wildlife from DEC, and that a simple rehabilitators license would not permit Mr. Longo's current possession of the raccoon or the squirrel even if he had one.

10/29/24 I completed the search warrant, search warrant application, and operational plan. The above were reviewed by [REDACTED], and [REDACTED]. We spoke and I made minor modifications to the documents. I was given approval to proceed with the case.

I spoke to [REDACTED] several times and tasked him with making the appropriate contacts with Chemung Co DOH. I also tasked him to work with BOW staff and locate a wildlife rehabilitator that would take the squirrel if DOH approved it. He confirmed that he had located a rehabilitator and had spoken to DOH. I requested that he send me a street view photo or two of 37 Beckwith Rd Pine City NY to be included in my warrant application as an attachment.

The warrant, application, and attachments were taken to the [REDACTED] office for signature at approximately 1330. I patrolled back to the Bath Office to prepare the operational plan and organize personnel to execute the warrant on October 30th, 2024.

10/29/24 At [REDACTED] direction I contacted [REDACTED] and requested she assist us with the warrant tomorrow because there may be a female at the residence. I also spoke to [REDACTED] who stated he will likely assist at the warrant tomorrow as BOW supervisor due to the nature of this case.

10/20/24 0930 All personnel met at T/Southport Highway Dept for a briefing. 3 DEC Investigators, 1 Investigator Lieutenant, 4 Uniform ECOs, 1 Uniform Lieutenant, and 3 Bureau of Wildlife staff were present. We consolidated vehicles and at approximately 1030 we patrolled to 37 Beckwith Rd Pine City, NY to execute the search warrant. I was the first person on site. Upon entering the driveway, I encountered a UTV on the side of the driveway, occupied by a male subject. I stopped, exited my patrol vehicle and identified myself. The male operating the UTV stated he was Mark Longo. I briefly spoke with Longo regarding his possession of the squirrel and raccoon at which time he denied having them anymore and began to tell me the squirrel posts were made by a fake account someone else made online. I asked Mr. Longo if we could meet him at his residence to speak about the matter further. He agreed to do so, and we all separately drove up the driveway and parked in front of the residence. I briefly spoke to Longo, and he again denied having the squirrel and raccoon on the property. I handed Longo a copy of the search warrant to search the premises, and advised we would be doing so. Longo stated that the animals were not there, and that he knew the laws about having the squirrel in NY, from speaking to another officer earlier that year. Longo stated that the squirrel was currently in Connecticut and that he had 4 raccoons earlier in the year, but they were all released. Longo stated that he would not give us a hard time in our search. I asked Longo for his identification at which time he provided me with his NYS Drivers license. Uniform ECOs began a safety sweep of the property for additional persons and firearms.

During the safety sweep I located Daniela Bittner on the stairs of the basement. I briefly spoke to Daniela Bittner and identified myself. Bittner first denied having the animals on the property, but then admitted the raccoon was in a closet upstairs. I asked Bittner for her identification at which time she handed me what she described as a Germany drivers license, and a Germany identification. I asked her if she had any other paperwork and what her status in the US was.

10/30/24 approximately 1120
Toward the end of the safety sweep [REDACTED] and I checked the outbuildings and contacted [REDACTED], a logger working on the property several hundred yards away. We advised him he could continue his work and that we were conducting a search warrant.

I was advised that during the safety sweep several firearms were located and held for safe keeping by [REDACTED] in his vehicle. I met with [REDACTED] outside and took notes regarding the firearms. Officers located the following firearms and components.

Delta Level Defense Model CT4-2A .300 blackout rifle Serial # CT698
Delta Level Defense Model CT4-2A 5.56X45 Nato complete upper receiver ID# S1014
Two MFT 5.56X45 10 round magazines for above rifle
Ammo can containing .556 ammunition
Savage Axis rifle with scope 6.5 Creedmoor serial # P925887
Savage model 1905 .22lr Serial # 34001

Entry photos were taken by BECI Staff after the completion of the safety sweep.

At that point I asked Daniela Bittner if she could show me where the raccoon was located. At that point she accompanied me to a back closet in an upstairs bedroom. Bittner pointed out that the raccoon was inside a soft sided suitcase on the floor of the closet. We closed the closet door and I later accompanied Bureau of wildlife staff to the closet where I zipped the suitcase closed and removed it from the closet to have room to work for our safety. [REDACTED] photographed the closet, the suitcase, and the raccoon. Bureau of wildlife staff took possession of the raccoon and placed it into an animal carrier and took it to their vehicle.

While in my patrol vehicle I ran the firearms through central dispatch and spoke to [REDACTED] regarding the legality of the Delta Level Defense rifle.

I spoke to the Chemung County District Attorneys office regarding possible PL 265 charges related to the Delta Level Defense rifle. They advised to hold the gun as evidence, and to amend the search warrant and they would get back to me regarding possible charges.

I left a message for [REDACTED] regarding my need to amend the search warrant relating to the firearm.

I contacted US Customs and Immigration office Buffalo to verify the documents Bittner gave me, and to check if she was a fugitive from justice. They advised they could not do that for me but directed me how to get the information in ejustice.

I contacted Central dispatch and asked they run the information in the manner the Customs officer had advised me to.

During that period, I was advised the officers located the squirrel in the residence. I walked to the residence and found Mark Longo in the middle of the upstairs staircase with officers above and below him. He was visibly upset. We spoke to Longo and advised the warrant allows and commands us to take the squirrel as evidence. He stated he knows he can't have it here and pleaded with us to allow him to take it to Connecticut today. He stated he knew we would be euthanizing it at which time I told him we would follow the recommendation of the NYS DOH. I walked Longo outside to prevent further escalation and we spoke regarding the Delta Level Defense rifle. Longo stated it was not his and that we could take it, he didn't care, just don't take the squirrel as it was a large source of the income for the farm. He stated the rifle was his friend [REDACTED] gun and provided me with [REDACTED] phone number. Longo stated that [REDACTED] brought the gun there from Connecticut last year and that [REDACTED] hasn't been there in a while since [REDACTED] doesn't get along with his wife. Longo stated it was in the dining area because Longo brought it down there due to his concerns over a person that lived nearby with mental health issues.

I met with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] photographed the firearms.

I observed the squirrel and raccoon in carriers in the back of BOW truck. I spoke to [REDACTED] of BOW and was notified that she had been bitten by the squirrel through the protective gloves. I observed a small wound on her finger. BOW left shortly thereafter with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was to contact DOH to determine how to handle both animals, based upon the exposures.

I was advised exit photos were being taken by BECI staff. [REDACTED] did a sketch of the residence and provided it to me.

██████████, who was staying with Longo and Bittner outside advised me that Longo and Bittner were requesting us to let them do chores, and I agreed that was fine. I spoke to Longo and told him we were just waiting on the Judge to get back to me prior to us leaving, and that was why it was taking so long. I told him he could do chores, but I would need him to return to the house later so that I could return some of the firearms to him prior to our leaving.

Bittner approached me and asked for my business card. I walked with her to my patrol vehicle and provided her my business card. She stated she had a complaint of another person with a squirrel. Bittner thanked me for being so nice about the search and that if this happened in Germany, they would have been not so nice. I thanked her and I agreed to take her complaint when she had it for me. Prior to leaving the property Bittner handed me a handwritten note with information regarding the complaint of another person with a squirrel.

I spoke to Judge ██████████ via phone regarding my need to amend the search warrant relating to the firearm. He approved me leaving the site with the firearm in my possession, and to file a search warrant amendment with him by the end of the day.

Upon leaving the property I served 2 evidence custody forms to Mark Longo for Items 1,2,3,4. Longo had signed the form containing evidence 1,2. I advised Longo that there would be some charges filed when I heard back from the DAs office.

I returned the following items to Mark Longo.

Two MFT 5.56X45 10 round magazines for above rifle
Ammo can containing .556 ammunition

I returned Bittners Germany ID, and Germany Drivers license to her.

Upon leaving we noticed that due to DLE vehicles in the driveway an amazon package had been left in the driveway. I walked back to the residence and let Longo know that their package was in the drive. He thanked me for the notification.

All participants were clear the residence at 1409 without further incident.

We patrolled to and met at briefing site. I spoke to ██████████ to advise we were all clear property. I also briefly spoke to ██████████ regarding any media inquiries.

10/30/24 1430 ECI ██████████ patrolled to the Chemung County Court. I amended the search warrant, and application in my patrol vehicle, printed it and met with the Judge ██████████ at which time he signed the amended warrant, and application.

I spoke with ██████████ via phone. ██████████ stated the Delta Level Defense rifle and complete upper receiver were his and that he brought it to NY from CT last year. Guasco stated he had it at the house to shoot it some. Guasco asked if it was a problem or if he would be arrested. I advised him it was not a legal firearm to own in NY and I was awaiting an answer from the DAs office regarding possible charges.

I spoke to ██████████ via phone and provided basic details regarding my investigation, the warrant execution, and the status of the animals.

I spoke to ██████████ who stated that the DOH advised him that due to the nature of the exposure the raccoon and squirrel were euthanized by Elmira Animal Control on behalf of the DOH and were to be sent for rabies testing.

I patrolled to the Avon office to place the firearm, and the complete firearm upper receiver into evidence, filing the chain of custody forms in Avon.

On Wednesday October 30, 2024, at approximately 0930 DEC members met for a pre warrant briefing. At approximately 1035 hours we arrived at 37 Beckwith Road, T/Southport, Chemung County. Upon arrival at 37 Beckwith Road, [REDACTED] initiated contact with MARK LONGO on a UTV. [REDACTED] directed M. LONGO to meet him in front of the house so that vehicles could park closer. Upon meeting MARK J. LONGO, [REDACTED] in front of his house he was identified by his NYS driver license. [REDACTED] inquired about the unlawfully possessed wildlife at the residence. M. LONGO denied that any wildlife would be found in the house. M. LONGO stated that we would need a warrant to enter the house. [REDACTED] served M. LONGO the search warrant at this time. A safety sweep was performed immediately after the warrant service, during the safety sweep several firearms were located and held for safe keeping. M. LONGO went with officers during the safety sweep. Inv. CRAIN and I spoke with M. LONGO's wife, DANIELA BITTNER 04/23/1996, and she admitted to us that a RACCOON was upstairs in a bedroom closet.

M. LONGO stated that the RACCOON was the only wild animal in the residence, saying that the SQUIRREL was taken to Connecticut.

At this time photographers took entry photographs and [REDACTED] and I checked other buildings and spoke with a logger who was on the property cutting trees and deemed immaterial to the warrant and was allowed to continue working.

Upon completion of the entry photographs we located a raccoon in an upstairs closet inside a piece of luggage. [REDACTED] photographed the closet, the suitcase, and the RACCOON. DEC WILDLIFE STAFF placed the raccoon into a crate and removed it from the residence. I continued a search of the premises and as I walked by the upstairs bathroom I observed a black SQUIRREL on the bathtub. I secured the door and heard M. LONGO asking us not to take the SQUIRREL. M. LONGO was on the stairwell with [REDACTED] and stated that PEANUT, THE SQUIRREL, was the main source of income that M. LONGO used to fund his animal sanctuary. I informed M. LONGO that he would not be able to continue to possess the SQUIRREL. M. LONGO was escorted back outside. DEC WILDLIFE STAFF entered the bathroom and placed the SQUIRREL into a crate and removed it from the residence.

I advised [REDACTED] to contact the judge and have the warrant amended to include the seizure of the AR-15. [REDACTED] advised me that JUDGE [REDACTED] verbally approved an amended warrant for the seizure of the rifle.

After the warrant was amended, I assisted the search team in filling out chain of custody forms for the seizure of a RACCOON, a SQUIRREL and an AR-15.

After this, I observed the SQUIRREL and RACCOON in carriers with DEC WILDLIFE STAFF. DEC WILDLIFE TECHNICIAN, [REDACTED] said she had been bitten by the SQUIRREL through the protective gloves. I observed a small wound on her finger.

Exit photographs were taken of the residence interior and exterior.

I cleared the scene at approximately 1410 shortly before the entire team cleared. END OF REPORT.
