This training is MANDAORY for all managers and highly encouraged for all DC Employees to complete by July 30th. 2025. Intro to LGBTQIA+ Training

This training goes beyond surface-level awareness, delving into critical areas such as:

- Intersectionality: Understanding the complex interplay of various social identities.
- **Health Disparities:** Recognizing and addressing the unique health challenges faced by the LGBTQIA+ community.
- Legal Protections: Gaining clarity on relevant laws and policies.
- **Creating Inclusive Environments:** Practical strategies for building a respectful and supportive workplace for all.

How to Access the Training:

1. PeopleSoft Access:

- a. Log in to PeopleSoft.
- b. Click "Request Training."
- c. Select "Course Search."
- d. Enter course number "AQ100" and search.

Important: Ensure your pop-up blocker is disabled.

2. eHealthHIV Platform:

- a. You will be redirected to the eHealthHIV website.
- b. Create your account on the eHealthHIV platform.
- c. Click "Course Search" within eHealthHIV.
- d. Search for "LGBTQIA+ Cultural Humility: A Space for Queer Life" and click the top search result link.
- e. Complete all modules and steps within the training.

3. Continuing Education (CE) Credits:

- a. Upon successful completion of the Knowledge Check, health professionals can request two (2) Continuing Education (CE) credits.
- b. Follow the provided step-by-step guide on the eHealthHIV platform to claim your credits.

4. Course Completion Credit:

a. After finishing the training, please complete the survey on the course homepage within PeopleSoft to receive credit for your participation.
