The FBI has completed its third review of records subject to the Freedom of Information/Privacy Acts (FOIPA) that are responsive to your request. The enclosed documents were reviewed under the FOIPA, Title 5, United States Code, Section 552/552a. In response to your Freedom of Information/Privacy Acts (FOIPA) request, enclosed is a processed copy of Bates-stamped pages FBI(25-cv-2216)-506 through FBI(25-cv-2216)-761. This is the third interim release of information responsive to your FOIPA request. This material is being provided to you at no charge.

A document was located which originated with, or contained information concerning, another Government Agency [OGA]. We are consulting with the other agency and are awaiting their response. The FBI will correspond with you regarding the document when the consultation is completed.

As referenced in our letter responding to your Freedom of Information/Privacy Acts (FOIPA) request, the FBI FOIPA Addendum provides information applicable to your request. Part 1 of the Addendum includes standard responses that apply to all requests. Part 2 includes standard responses that apply to requests for records about individuals to the extent your request seeks the listed information. Part 3 includes general information about FBI records, searches, and programs.

Part 1: The standard responses below apply to all requests:

- (i) **5 U.S.C. § 552(c).** Congress excluded three categories of law enforcement and national security records from the requirements of the FOIPA [5 U.S.C. § 552(c)]. FBI responses are limited to those records subject to the requirements of the FOIPA. Additional information about the FBI and the FOIPA can be found on the www.fbi.gov/foia website.
- (ii) **Intelligence Records.** To the extent your request seeks records of intelligence sources, methods, or activities, the FBI can neither confirm nor deny the existence of records pursuant to FOIA exemptions (b)(1), (b)(3), and as applicable to requests for records about individuals, PA exemption (j)(2) [5 U.S.C. §§ 552/552a (b)(1), (b)(3), and (j)(2)]. The mere acknowledgment of the existence or nonexistence of such records is itself a classified fact protected by FOIA exemption (b)(1) and/or would reveal intelligence sources, methods, or activities protected by exemption (b)(3) [50 USC § 3024(i)(1)]. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that any such records do or do not exist.

The mere acknowledgment of the existence or nonexistence of such records would reveal confidential informant identities and information, expose law enforcement techniques, and endanger the life or physical safety of individuals. This is a standard response and should not be read to indicate that such records do or do not exist.

- (i) **Record Searches and Standard Search Policy.** The Record/Information Dissemination Section (RIDS) searches for reasonably described records by searching systems, such as the Central Records System (CRS), or locations where responsive records would reasonably be found. The CRS is an extensive system of records consisting of applicant, investigative, intelligence, personnel, administrative, and general files compiled by the FBI per its law enforcement, intelligence, and administrative functions. The CRS spans the entire FBI organization, comprising records of FBI Headquarters, FBI Field Offices, and FBI Legal Attaché Offices (Legats) worldwide; Electronic Surveillance (ELSUR) records are included in the CRS. The standard search policy is a search for main entity records in the CRS. Unless specifically requested, a standard search does not include a search for reference entity records or administrative records of previous FOIPA requests.
 - a. *Main Entity Records* – created for individuals or non-individuals who are the subjects or the focus of an investigation
 - b. *Reference Entity Records*- created for individuals or non-individuals who are associated with a case but are not known subjects or the focus of an investigation
- (ii) **FBI Records.** Founded in 1908, the FBI carries out a dual law enforcement and national security mission. As part of this dual mission, the FBI creates and maintains records on various subjects; however, the FBI does not maintain records on every person, subject, or entity.
- (iii) **Foreseeable Harm Standard.** As amended in 2016, the Freedom of Information Act provides that a federal agency may withhold responsive records only if: (1) the agency reasonably foresees that disclosure would harm an interest protected by one of the nine exemptions that FOIA enumerates, or (2) disclosure is prohibited by law (5 United States Code, Section 552(a)(8)(A)(i)). The FBI considers this foreseeable harm standard in the processing of its requests.
- (iv) **Requests for Criminal History Records or Rap Sheets.** The Criminal Justice Information Services (CJIS) Division provides Identity History Summary Checks – often referred to as a criminal history record or rap sheet. These criminal history records are not the same as material in an investigative “FBI file.” An Identity History Summary Check is a listing of information taken from fingerprint cards and documents submitted to the FBI in connection with arrests, federal employment, naturalization, or military service. - (b)(7) records or information compiled for law enforcement purposes, but only to the extent that the production of such law enforcement records or information (A) could reasonably be expected to interfere with enforcement proceedings, (B) would deprive a person of a right to a fair trial or an impartial adjudication, (C) could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, (D) could reasonably be expected to disclose the identity of confidential source, including a State, local, or foreign agency or authority or any private institution which furnished information on a confidential basis, and, in the case of record or information compiled by a criminal law enforcement authority in the course of a criminal investigation, or by an agency conducting a lawful national security intelligence investigation, information furnished by a confidential source, (E) would disclose techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions, or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions if such disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law, or (F) could reasonably be expected to endanger the life or physical safety of any individual;
- (b)(8) contained in or related to examination, operating, or condition reports prepared by, on behalf of, or for the use of an agency responsible for the regulation or supervision of financial institutions; or
- (b)(9) geological and geophysical information and data, including maps, concerning wells.

Deputy [redacted] was interviewed at the Butler County Government Center (124 W. Diamond St. Butler, PA. 16001) by Corporal [redacted] (Pennsylvania State Police) and TFO [redacted]. After being advised of the identity of the interviewing Agents and the nature of the interview, [redacted] provided the following information:

Deputy [redacted] is employed with the Butler County Sheriff's Office (BCSO). [redacted] could not recall the exact day that she was informed of the Trump rally. On July 11, 2024, [redacted] was told that she would be working the event. [redacted] believes that she was given her specific posting (Post 4) on Friday, July 12, 2024. [redacted] was sent a map that showed the layout of the event site and where the various posts throughout the site were located. [redacted] confirmed the map and officer roster, provided to interviewers by Chief Deputy [redacted] was what she had received on July 12th at 3:37pm via email. No other formal briefings were provided. [redacted] asked [redacted] what the role of posts 3, 4, 5, and 6 were? she was told that those posts were to monitor and make sure the fence line remained secure. [redacted] was not involved with any of the planning for the rally. [redacted] was not briefed on the use of deadly force prior to the event.

[redacted] was not familiar with the Butler Farm Show grounds prior to the rally. [redacted] arrived at approximately 10:40am and [redacted] personally drove her to her post. No other ops plans were given to [redacted] position was in front of the AGR building. [redacted] position was between two fence lines with the rally site behind her. [redacted] could see the front and left sides of the AGR building. [redacted] had no field of view to the right or back sides of the structure. [redacted] was unaware of any law enforcement presence at/in the ARG building. [redacted] didn't anticipate having any people gather at the AGR building. [redacted] was surprised that there ended up being approximately 100 in that area. [redacted] confirmed that the group of people were on the opposite side of the fence line from her position. [redacted] reported that she and a PSP trooper had to address a few problems "a few hours" before the arrival of Trump. [redacted] stated that there was a guy wearing a red cut-off shirt (mid to early 20's, 5'7 170

lbs.) who was waving to her. At that time, [REDACTED] stated that the trooper to her right was talking with a Butler ESU team member. [REDACTED] stated that when she approached the fence line, an older guy in his 50's whom she thought was the owner of AGR was requesting that people be removed from the property. [REDACTED] asked if the owner meant the guy in the red cut-off shirt, to which the owner replied that he wanted everyone off the property. With the assistance of the trooper at Post 5 the crowd was ordered to move back from the area towards a group of trees. [REDACTED] also described a male in a neon green shirt that was acting "different". He was 6'0 tall, 160 lbs., dark hair, glasses, hat and long dark pants. [REDACTED] stated that at least 3 times she approached the fence line to speak to him and all three times he looked and walked away from her. At no time did she ask for the identification of red shirt or neon green shirt. [REDACTED] did say that neon green shirt acted as though he was filming once Trump got on stage.

[REDACTED] recalled calling Sgt. [REDACTED] to verify what channel they were operating on. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that she could hear radio traffic of the event on "police ops 3" and "police ops 4". [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] to remain on the "sheriff's channel". [REDACTED] knowing that she might have to speak to officers on both channels, tuned her portable radio to "sheriff's channel" while tuning her car radio to "police ops 3". [REDACTED] did state that it was at times difficult to discern what agency was talking on the radio.

[REDACTED] stated that cell phone service was very spotty during the event. [REDACTED] stated that she had to restart her phone multiple times. [REDACTED] stated that the trooper at Post 5 also was having difficulties with his phone. [REDACTED] stated that the trooper at Post 5 had to use her phone to call PSP resources to attempt to clear the people from the AGR property. That call was made at approximately 5:15pm. After that request a PSP vehicle was seen in the area of the water tower.

At some point prior to the arrival of Trump, [REDACTED] recalled hearing radio traffic from Sgt. [REDACTED] on the sheriff's channel requesting officers to be on the lookout (BOLO) for a man on a bike with long hair, grey shirt, backpack and possibly wearing a hat. [REDACTED] saw an older male on a bike wearing a white shirt, with short hair that was determined to not be the subject. [REDACTED] asked why they were looking for this male and was told that he was seen with a range finder. [REDACTED] continued to keep an eye on red shirt and neon green shirt while scanning the crowd for the BOLO subject. [REDACTED] never saw the BOLO subject in person. [REDACTED] had received a photo of the subject via text from Sgt. [REDACTED] at 5:53pm. [REDACTED] never received information from the crowd regarding the BOLO subject. [REDACTED] heard

someone on the radio saying, "long gun". [REDACTED] repeated "long gun" on the sheriff's channel. [REDACTED] began to see police officers running around the AGR building. [REDACTED] was in the process of going towards Post 5 to share the photo with PSP when the shots were fired. [REDACTED] estimated 5-6 rounds fired. [REDACTED] believed that shots came from in front of her at the AGR building. [REDACTED] immediately exited her vehicle, withdrew her firearm and was prepared to engage any threat that she saw. [REDACTED] was still between fence lines, so she was unable to move towards the AGR building. [REDACTED] did not engage in any further enforcement actions.
